



Caroline N. Libersky

October 29, 1926 - December 15, 2003

Caroline N. Libersky of Centreville, MD, died on Monday, December 15, 2003, at the Chester River Hospital, Chestertown, MD, following a brave battle with cancer. She was 77.

Born on October 29, 1926, in Brooklyn, NY, she was the daughter of the late Royal and Helen Werner Newbegin. After graduating from high school in 1944, she began working as a secretary for Railway Express. She married Anthony Libersky on October 21, 1950. In 1954, they moved to the Eastern Shore making their home for the next 26 years on a farm near Chestertown until Mr. Libersky's death in October 1980.

Mrs. Libersky was an avid flower and vegetable gardener who thoroughly loved watching things grow. She also enjoyed reading, crocheting, and watching old movies. She tackled numerous arts and crafts projects over the years. Many hours were spent designing and constructing miniature shadowbox scenes, many with Christmas themes.

Over the years, she was active in church activities, singing in the choir and teaching Sunday School and Vacation Bible School. Most recently, she was a lay reader for the early services at St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Church Hill. She had a strong faith and a generous heart, often quietly helping people she knew were in need.

Perhaps her greatest pleasure was her involvement with her grandchildren. She was devoted to them and participated energetically in their activities.

Mrs. Libersky is survived by two daughters, Helen Benchoff (Jim) of Centreville, MD, Barbara Brendle and (Gary) of Annapolis; one brother, Roy Newbegin (Myong-ja) of Queens, NY; a sister, Helen Maresca, of Ridgewood, NJ; three grandchildren, Tony Cecil, Cubby and Courtney Brendle; and four-month-old great-grandson, Blake Cecil. She is also survived by several nieces and nephews.

Services will be held in the Chapel at the Veterans Cemetery in Hurlock on Thursday, December 18, at 1:00 PM.

Burial will follow immediately at the cemetery next to her husband.
