Caroline S. Horsman, of Easton, MD, died peacefully at her home in the arms of her beloved husband on Wednesday, September 4, 2002. She was 79.

Born in Cordova, October 24, 1922, she was the daughter of the late Julius George and Bertha Rebecca Hartz Schwarten. After graduating from Cordova High School in 1939, she worked in Easton until moving to North Carolina. Upon her return to the Eastern Shore she worked as a secretary for Nationwide Insurance in Easton. She later became a claims adjuster for Nationwide in Newark, DE, and Harrisburg, PA, before receiving another promotion that moved her to Illinois as an Administrative Assistant. After another promotion, she moved to the company headquarters in Columbus, OH, where she was a claims trainer at the Nationwide Training Center. She retired from this position in 1986 and moved to Easton.

She was a member of the Talbot County Women's Club, the Talbot County Chapter of the Izaak Walton League, the Talbot County Historical Society, and the Mid-Shore Antique Club. She enjoyed traveling and going on cruises.

Mrs. Horsman is survived by her husband, Jesse L. Horsman, whom she married in 1988; his four children, Laura H. Selby, Douglas L. Horsman and Claudia E. Hampsher, all of Rockville, MD and John S. Horsman of Pikesville, MD; three brothers, Alfred Schwarten and Hans Schwarten, both of Cordova,

and Thomas Swarten of Easton; six grandchildren; and one great-granddaughter.

Funeral services will be held at the Fairview Church of The Brethren, Cordova, on Saturday September 7, 2002 at 11:00 AM. Burial will be in the Fairview Church Cemetery in Cordova.
