Caroline Henrietta Manley Starr passed away peacefully at her home in Rock Hall, MD on November 15, 2025. She was 88 years old.

She was born in Baltimore, MD on August 15, 1937, the daughter of the late John and Caroline Gibson. She attended Baltimore city schools until her family moved to Rock Hall, where she attended Rock Hall High School. In July of 1954, she married Charles Manley, who preceded her in death in 1994. In September of 2006, she married Thomas R. Starr, who preceded her in death in 2010. She worked at Baltimore Business Forms and then LaMotte Chemical until her retirement.

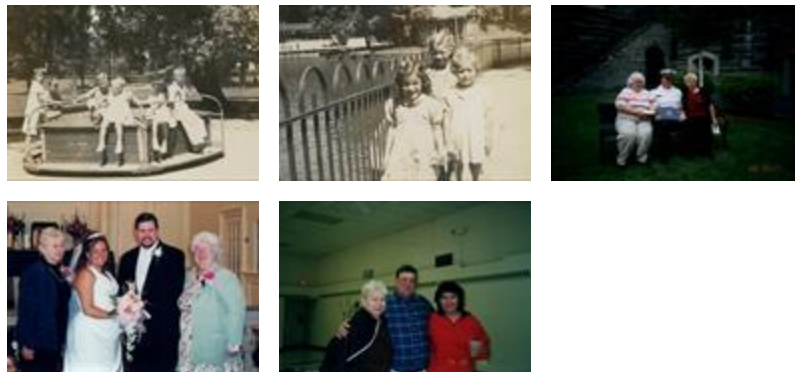

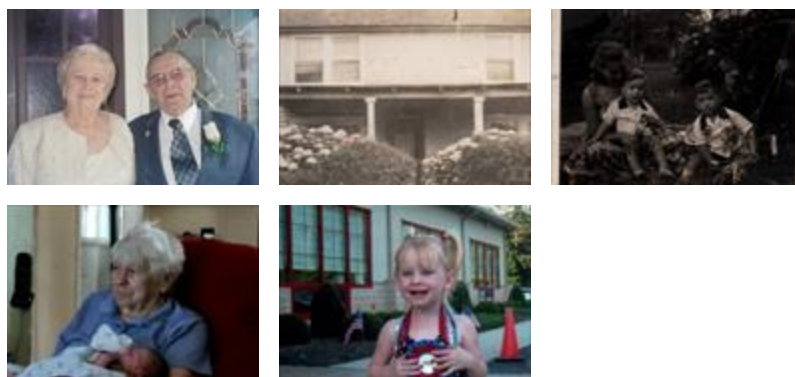

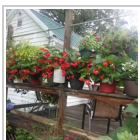
