



## Carolyn Todd Dobyns

December 5, 1932 - June 17, 2024

Carolyn Wilson Dobyns of Grasonville, MD, beloved wife of the late Richard Allison Dobyns, Jr., passed away on Monday, June 17, 2024 at the age of 91. She was born on December 5, 1932 in Princess Anne, MD to the late Reginald H. and Mabel Webster Wilson, the fourth of five daughters.

She attended schools there and was a graduate of Washington High School in Princess Anne, class of 1949. Carolyn worked as a legal secretary in Salisbury, MD for a few years. She married her husband of 56 years on July 6, 1956 in Princess Anne. They moved to Raleigh, NC while her husband attended college. After his graduation they moved to Ithaca, NY, and then to Severna Park, MD, where they raised their children. She and her husband moved to the Eastern Shore in 1982. Carolyn retired in 1995 after working for 21 years for Bruce S. Hughes, CPA in Severna Park. Carolyn was a Charter volunteer of Hospice of Queen Anne's County (now Compass Regional Hospice) and a Charter volunteer of Estate Treasures, the hospice resale shop in Chester, MD (now Compass Closet). She was a member of the Nanticoke Chapter of the DAR; the American Legion Auxiliary, Post 296; the Women of the Moose, Bay Country Chapter; the Kent Island Yacht Club; and the Kent Island Heritage Society.

In addition to her parents and husband, Carolyn was predeceased by all four sisters; Lorraine W. Long, Jeannette W. Croswell, and Betty W. Simpkins, all

of the Princess Anne, MD area; and Regina W. Miller of the Seattle, WA area. Carolyn is survived by two daughters; Jeri Lynn Alls (David) of Fort Mill, SC, and Allison D. Lucas (Taylor) of Cockeysville, MD; and two sons, Richard A. Dobyms III (Sue), of Severna Park, MD and Robert W. Dobyms (Becki) of Ellicott City, MD. Also surviving are eight grandchildren Stephen Alls (Anna) of Myrtle Beach, SC; Jenna Alls Martin (Joel) of Fort Mill, SC; Daniel Lucas (Kelsey) of Phoenix, MD; Patrick Lucas (Emily) of Park Ridge, IL; Allison A. Dobyms and Caroline Dobyms, both of New York, NY; Kathryn Dobyms of Annapolis, MD; and Erin Dobyms of Ellicott City, MD and 10 great-grandchildren. She is also survived by many nieces and nephews and their families.
