



Carolyn Greenwood Lachenmayr

November 6, 1942 - August 15, 2023

Carolyn Greenwood Lachenmayr of Easton, MD, (formerly of Hagerstown) passed away peacefully on August 15, 2023. Born in Tacoma, WA, on November 6, 1942, to the late Harry Ellwyn and Lois Myrtle (Fawcett) Greenwood, Carolyn spent her formative years on the West Coast, finally settling in Watsonville, CA, where she graduated high school.

Carolyn later attended the California Polytechnic State University in San Luis Obispo, where she had the seminal experience of helping to design and build the university's float for the Rose Bowl Parade. She graduated from San Francisco State University, earning a Bachelor of Arts. After living in San Francisco for a few years, her adventurous spirit took her to Bremerhaven, Germany, where she worked as a civilian for the Department of the Army, leading tours, hosting a radio program, and generally boosting troop morale. There she met and married her husband of 56 years, Walter.

Carolyn was fantastically creative and incredibly generous with her time and talents. She and her sister spent decades researching her family history, attending genealogy conferences and made many pen pals and friends in the process. She used her expertise and passion for interior design to teach community college classes and to consult on home and office renovations. She was active in the community, including the Blooms and Blessings Garden Club, and served for many years as a Girl Scout troop leader. Carolyn was an

accomplished craftsperson and loved to make Christmas decorations for friends and family. Her lovely garden was her sanctuary.

Carolyn is survived by her beloved husband, Walter, of Easton; her two daughters, Lisa and Christa; her son-in-law, Jonathan Boxwell; her grandson, Nelson Boxwell; her sister, Judy Jones (husband Donald); brother, Steve Greenwood (wife Lynn); and many nieces and nephews.

A funeral and interment will be held on Friday, September 29 at 11 a.m. at Saints Peter and Paul Church in Easton.
