Carolyn Vogt Taylor of Easton, MD, formerly of Washington, DC, died at the Brighton Gardens of Tuckerman Lane, North Bethesda, MD, Sunday, December 17, 2000. She was 85.

Born in Washington, DC, March 11, 1915, she was the daughter of the late Frederick L. and Eleanor Schulz Vogt. After graduating from Western High School in Washington in 1932, she attended the University of Maryland where she received her degree in Home Economics in 1936. In 1940, she married Dr. Robert G. Taylor, and they lived in Washington until moving to Easton in 1969. Dr. Taylor died on September 12, 1993.

A member of the Presbyterian Church of Easton and the Presbyterian Women of the Church, she was also a member of the Talbot Country Club, Poplar Island Yacht Club, and was affiliated with the St. Andrews Society.

Mrs. Taylor is survived by a son, Robert F. Taylor and his wife, Betty, of Bethesda, MD; a daughter, Jane T. Ryan and her husband, Jack, of Potomac, MD; four grandchildren, Robert S. Taylor and his wife, Megan, of Frederick, MD, Lt. David F. Taylor U.S.N. of Whitby Island, WA, Carolyn R. Decker and her husband, Eric, of Dover, NH, and John J. Ryan, Jr., of Charleston, SC; and one great-grandson, Robert Kenneth Taylor.
