Carroll A. Coleman, Sr. of Union Bridge, died at the North Arundel Hospital, Glen Burnie, MD on Tuesday, July 29, 2003. He was 74.

Born in Trappe, MD, December 19, 1928, he was one of thirteen children of the late Howard Lee and Clara Elizabeth Skipper Coleman. After attending public school, he worked on a farm for five years before beginning his career as a carpenter. He worked for J. Russell Summers, Inc. in Easton until moving to the Western Shore in 1964. There he remained active as a carpenter until medically retiring in 1992.

Mr. Coleman, or "Buddy" as he was best-known, liked to race go-karts, bowl and to coach in the Babe Ruth League.

Surviving, are his wife, the former Mary Joan Haddaway whom he married in St. Michaels on April 11, 1952; four sons, Carroll A. Coleman, Jr. of Frederick, MD, Kirk D. Coleman of Union Bridge, MD, David L. Coleman of Jefferson, MD and Brooks R. Coleman of Mt. Airy, MD; three sisters, Rebecca Coleman of Cambridge, Virginia Hurley of Vienna and Etta Bainbridge of Rockford, IL; two brothers, G. William Coleman of Rockville, MD and Elmer C. Coleman of Rockford, IL and six grandchildren.
