Carroll Bernard Higdon of Chester, MD died on Thursday, May 6, 2010 at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 79 years old.

Carroll "Cal" or "Dudley" Higdon was born on December 3, 1930 in Baltimore, MD to the late John B. Higdon and Rosalie A. Carroll Higdon. He attended St. Edwards, graduating class of 1945. Later attending Mount Saint Joseph, he graduated in 1949. He served with the U.S. Marines during the Korean War from 1952 to 1954. He was honorably discharged and returned home.

Mr. Higdon began his career as a local surveyor with the State of Maryland, retiring in 1981; with 32 years of employment with the state. After his retirement he began consulting privately in Baltimore for S.T.V. Consultants.

On March 21, 1987, he married Carolyn D. Ross and resided on Kent Island.

Mr. Higdon was a member of the American Legion and the Queen Anne's County Waterman's Association. He enjoyed softball, crabbing, fishing, hunting, growing vegetables and football. He played football for 18 years and softball until he was 56 years old.

Mr. Higdon and his wife, Carolyn, have three children, Theresa A. Higdon, Patricia L. Foss and Donna L. D'Antuono; and nine grandchildren, Hunter D'Antuono, Olivia D'Antuono, Isabella D'Antuono, Dusty Schulz, Kirby Schulz, Kolby Schulz, Dorsey Schulz, Anna Foss and Cade Jones.

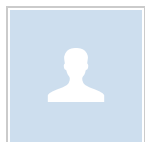
