



## Carrol R. Turman

Carrol Raymond Turman of Stevensville died on Monday, May 20, 2002 at the Anne Arundel Medical Center, Annapolis. He was 74.

Born in Ivydale, WV on February 8, 1928, he was the son of the late Walter Elliott and Selva Bryan Turman. At the age of 17 he joined the U.S. Army and was a highly decorated combat veteran serving in World War II and the Korean War and he was a liaison during the Vietnam War. During the Korean War he served in the 3rd Infantry, 7th Regiment of the U.S. Army. During his military career he received the Silver Star, the Bronze Star and the Purple Heart due to being wounded in action and in 1965 he was discharged as a Master Sergeant. In 1966 he married Gloria JeanThompson and they made their home in Glen Burnie. Following his release from active duty he began a career with the Dept. of Corrections, serving in Patuxent and at his retirement he was at the Eastern Shore Pre-Release facility in Church Hill. He was a very skilled craftsman and in 1977 they moved to Stevensville where he had built his own home.

Mr. Turman thoroughly enjoyed his family and his grandchildren.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Turman is survived by two daughters, Terry T. Meil of Ridgely and Judith A. Spiker of Glen Burnie; two stepdaughters, Robin G. Ellison of Glen Burnie and Kelly L. Meyers of Pasadena; a brother, Joseph E.

Turman of Catlisburg, KY; eight grandchildren and a number of great grandchildren. He was pre-deceased by two brothers.

Funeral Services will be held at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, Chester, MD on Friday, May 24, 2002 at 11:00 AM where friends and family may call on Thursday evening from 6 – 8 PM.

Burial will be in Stevensville Cemetery, Stevensville, MD.
