November 11, 1919 - January 14, 2013

Carter Richard Bryden of Chestertown, MD, died on Monday, January 14, 2013, at Chester River Hospital Center. He was 93.

Mr. Bryden was born on November 11, 1919, in Rock Hall, MD. He was the son of the late S. Arnold and Jennie West Pearman Bryden. Mr. Bryden graduated from Rock Hall High School. He served in the United States Navy and was honorably discharged in 1945. Mr. Bryden was married to Caroline Hadaway for 35 years. He later married Hester Slagle in 1976. Mr. Bryden was an agent with United Insurance Company of American and retired in 1984 as manager.

He was a member of Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church, Frank M. Jarman American Legion Post #36 in Chestertown, and the Chestertown Cruising Club. He was also a very active member of the Chester Lodge #115 A.F & A.M. Mr. Bryden was an avid bowler. He enjoyed traveling, hunting, fishing, and crabbing.
