Catherine Clough Brommer of Smyrna, DE, passed away Thursday, July 22, 2021, at her great-niece's home in Felton, DE. She was 97.

Catherine "Ms. Kitty" Brommer was born March 20, 1924 in Sudlersville, MD. She was the daughter of the late Joel N. Clough and Annie "Ware" Clough. Ms. Kitty worked as a banking bookkeeper for the Sudlersville Bank of Maryland for 42 years. She always enjoyed meeting new people and helping her friends and customers each day at the bank.
