



## Catherine Elise Gannon

April 19, 1935 - November 11, 2013

Catherine “Cathy” Gannon passed away at her home in Farmville, VA, on November 11, 2013.

She was born on April 19, 1935, in New York, daughter of the late Anna and Peter Kramer. Her parents moved to Cambridge, MD, in 1940, where she grew up and attended East New Market High School. After graduating high school, she went to Nursing School at McQueens, Gibbs, Willis School, and graduated in 1955.

She worked as a nurse for many years at Corsica Hills Nursing Home where she served as Director of Nursing. In the 1970's, she went on to the University of Maryland and received her Bachelor's degree. She taught nursing for a time at Queen Anne's High School and then went to work for the Del-Marva Foundation investigating Medicare fraud.
