



## Catherine L. Gordon

May 9, 1913 - June 11, 2013

Catherine Lipscomb Gordon died on June 11, 2013, at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation. She was 100.

She was born in Kennedyville, MD, on May 9, 1913, the daughter of the late Harry Cousins Lipscomb and Della Bramble Lipscomb. Ms. Gordon graduated from Chestertown High School in the Class of 1930 and Goldey Beacom Business School in 1932.
