February 4, 1919 - June 18, 2009

Catherine E. "Kitty" Gsell of Chestertown, MD died in her home on Thursday, June 18, 2009. She was 90 years old.

Mrs. Gsell was born in Baltimore, MD, the daughter of the late, Harry and Bella Groves Kramer. Mrs. Gsell was a homemaker but for many years, she served as the office manager for the Echo Hill Camp. 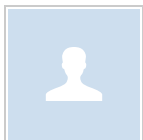
