



## Catherine M. Hauer

August 17, 1922 - December 17, 2015

Catherine M. Hauer passed away peacefully on December 17, 2015, at Anne Arundel Medical Center after a brief illness, with her family and friends at her side.

She was born Catherine Margaret Kline on August 17, 1922, being one of ten children of Appollonia and Charles Kline. She attended St. Joseph's School in Fullerton, MD, before marrying Francis (Butch) Hauer on January 15, 1944.

She lived in many locations as a Navy wife, including Norfolk VA, San Francisco, CA, Saipan Mariana Island, Patuxent River, and Clinton MD. While stationed at the Patuxent River NAS, she worked as a telephone switchboard operator where she put her excellent memory to practical use. She moved to Love Point in Stevensville, MD, in 1972 and was very proud of her contributions to the Kent Island Elks Lodge. As a member of Kent Island Ladies of the Elks, she served multiple terms as president and other leadership positions. She was also a member of the Ladies Auxiliary of the Knights of Columbus and served as its president and treasurer.

She was predeceased by her husband, Francis (Butch) Hauer in 2013.
