



## Catherine A. Passo

August 26, 1918 - October 17, 2012

Catherine A. Passo of Easton, MD, passed away October 17, 2012, at Memorial Hospital in Easton at the age of 94 after a brief illness.

She was born in Philadelphia, PA, on August 26, 1918, the first daughter of the late Joseph Trendler and Mary Ivanschitz Trendler who immigrated to America from Hungary.

She met her future husband, Willard C. Passo of Mead, NE, in the late 1930's. They were married on May 29, 1940, in Charleston, SC. They remained together for 46 years.

Her husband was in the Navy, so they moved many times from coast to coast and overseas, finding time between moves to have and raise two sons, William J. Passo and Michael A. Passo. After twenty years, they retired from the Navy and settled in Edgewater, MD, where they lived until Willard's death in 1986.

In 1990, Mrs. Passo moved to Easton, MD, to live with her son, William, and his wife, Barbara.

Her greatest joy was taking care of her family and the house. She spent her spare time with her hobbies of sewing and creating craft projects. She was an

avid bowler in her younger years.

Catherine is survived by her two sons, William J. Passo and his wife, Barbara of Easton, MD; and Michael A. Passo of Highspire, PA; two grandchildren, Christian J. Passo and his wife, Meghan of Salisbury, MD, and Douglas M. Passo and his wife, Beth of Milroy, PA; two great-grandchildren, Jazmine J. Passo of Milroy, PA, and William K. Passo of Salisbury, MD; and three brothers, Michael Trendler of Atco, NE, Phillip Trendler of Stratford, NJ, and William Trendler of Sparks, MD. Catherine was preceded in death by her other siblings, John Trendler, Joseph Trendler, Margaret Zador and Louise Woulk, all of Philadelphia, PA.
