



Catherine Viggars Reinbold

January 3, 1931 - March 7, 2022

Catherine Viggars Reinbold of Chestertown, MD, died on March 7, 2022, at the Resorts at Chester River Manor. She was 91.

Mrs. Reinbold was born in Wilmington, DE, on January 3, 1931, the daughter of David P. and Catherin Harvey Bevis. She graduated from Alexis I. DuPont High School in Wilmington and married Richard Viggars. The two lived in Wilmington, where they owned and operated the Pennyfeather shop from 1966 until the early 1990's. In 1982, she married William Reinbold, and they moved to Chestertown in 1985.

She was a volunteer with Red Cross, played golf, was a member of the Wilmington Country Club and Radley Run Country Club, and was a true lover of nature. She volunteered at the Tri-State Bird Rescue of Newark, DE, and the Eastern Neck Wildlife Reserve in Rock Hall, MD. She was an exceptional painter. She and her late husband built a home and spent much of their time in Portal, AZ, to watch birds.

She is survived by her niece, Pamela Wolf of Sudlersville, MD; her nephew, David P. Bevis of Fayetteville, AR; as well as her great-nieces and nephews, Eric Hanna, David Bevis, Tom Bevis, and Betsy Smith.
