



Catherine Eleanor Senseney

August 13, 1914 - April 8, 2013

Catherine Senseney, a long-time resident of Stevensville, MD, died late Monday evening, the 8th of April at Genesis Healthcare The Pines.

Born August 13, 1914, in Baltimore, MD, she was the daughter of the late Arthur and Olive May Evans Harkum. Catherine moved to Stevensville as a young teenager and was a graduate of Stevensville High School. She married Charles "Buck" Senseney and was a wife and homemaker until Buck's death in December 1970. She was very active in Christ Episcopal Church, where she taught Sunday school, sang in the choir, and participated in many other church activities. In 2002, she moved to The Pines.

Catherine is survived by her sister, Donna May Roland of Easton; granddaughters, Diane Sraver and her husband, Tom, of Timonium and Lisa Thomas of Clarksville; a grandson, Charles Edward Senseney and his wife, Elaine, of Cockeysville; and great-grandchildren Drew Sraver, Aimee Sraver, Cody Sraver, Joseph Senseney, Matthew Senseney and Elena Senseney.

In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by a son, Edward Collins Senseney, who died in 2006; a brother, Evans Harkum; and a sister, Mary Lou Thomas Sewell, who died in 2012.
