



## Catherine Drum Sullivan

A Funeral Liturgy for Catherine Drum Sullivan will be celebrated at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church on Thursday, May 27, 2004 at 1:00 PM. Mrs. Sullivan died on Monday, May 24, 2004 at her home in Easton. She was 74.

Born October 28, 1929 in Bayside on Long Island, New York, she was the daughter of the late Frank and Catherine McGuinness Drum. She and her husband, Thomas F. Sullivan, lived in Northport and Setauket on Long Island and Rumson, New Jersey before moving to Easton, MD in 1988. Mr. Sullivan died March 13, 2001.

A volunteer for the American Red Cross, she had served as President of the Mother Theresa Chapter and member of the Board of Directors of St. Charles Hospital Auxiliary in Port Jefferson, Long Island. She was a member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Easton where she had served on the Renew Program and the committee to write the Parish Council Constitution. She was a volunteer and member of the board of Memorial Hospital at Easton, was an active member of the adult literacy program "Project Read" in Talbot County and a member of the Talbot County Historical Society and Academy of The Arts.

Mrs. Sullivan is survived by two daughters, Coleen Sullivan Weissman of Colts Neck, NJ and Sheila Sullivan Snow of Portland, ME; a brother, Thomas

N. Drum of Ronkonkoma, Long Island; and three grandchildren, Kevin S. Weissman, Meaghan S. Weissman and Molly S. Snow.
