Catherine Godwin Meredith, of Centreville, a lifelong resident of Queen Anne's County and the widow of Fred Meredith, died peacefully on Tuesday, Nov. 30, 2004, at the Corsica Hills Nursing Home in Centreville. She was 91.

Born Alice Catherine Godwin on March 16, 1913, she was the daughter of Harry Godwin and Mary Elizabeth Morgan Godwin. She was a graduate of Centreville High School, Class of 1931.

Her husband, J. Fred Meredith, a well known farmer, whom she married on December 28, 1935, died September 15, 1995. Mrs. Meredith left her home on Spaniards Neck Road, Centreville in 1999 and entered the nursing home.
