Catherine Mae Walls of Centreville, MD died on Thursday, February 03, 2005 at Corsica Hills Nursing Home, Centreville, MD. She was 89.

Born January 1, 1916 in Starr, MD, she was the daughter of the late George Q. and Virgie Everett Morris. She married Marion E. Walls on September 10, 1932 and lived in Queen Anne's County all of her life. She worked as a seamstress for Perfect Garment Company, retiring in 1978 after 33 years of service.

She was an active member of the Centreville Rebekah Lodge #94 since May 1964, in recognition of her dedication to the lodge and her community service, she was awarded the highest honor, The Declaration of Civalry Jewel.

She was an active member of Goodwill Fire Company Ladies Auxiliary since 1966, where she volunteered her time faithfully during these years. The Fire Company presented her with the Margaret Brown award for outstanding services in 1983, 1985 and 1986, the last year the award was given. She was also a member of the Easton Women of the Moose Lodge #1250 for ten years.

She was a member of the Centreville United Methodist Church and was devoted to her church, donating her time graciously. Even though she was not

a member, she attended the Sunday evening services of the Pilgrim Holiness Church in Centreville.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Walls is survived by two daughters, Shirley Middleton of Houston, DE and Patricia Davis of Centreville; a brother, Colonel Edward F. Morris of Camden, DE; four grandchildren and 9 great grandchildren. She was pre-deceased by a brother, Burton Morris and a granddaughter, Brenda Sue Middleton who died February 15, 2004.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, February 7, 2005 at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Centreville, MD at 11:00 AM. Friends may call at the funeral home on Sunday, February 6, 2005 from 2 – 4 PM.
