



C. Dudley Reed

October 31, 1941 - January 17, 2009

C. Dudley Reed Sr. of Chestertown, Maryland, died on January 17, 2009, following a brief illness with lung cancer. He was 67.

He was born on October 31, 1941 and was raised by his grandparents, Herman and Rebecca (Berg) Hill on their Kent County farm. Mr. Reed attended school in Rock Hall, Maryland. He was married to Susan Witt for 20 years.

Mr. Reed began his career as a self-employed mason and worked as a farmer in the evenings. He started his own custom home building business and later worked as a developer, creating communities in both Kent and Queen Anne's Counties. Throughout his career as a farmer and later as a builder and developer, he remained a steward of the land.

Mr. Reed served as a Big Brother, enjoyed boating, was a member of the Crabtown Ski Club, and through his studies of history he became a Civil War expert. He was instrumental in helping to build additions to the Chestertown Baptist Church and the Rock Hall Seventh Day Adventist Church, and helped many other local churches. He last attended Covenant Baptist Church in Chestertown, Maryland.

He is survived by two sons: Charles D. Reed, Jr. and Roger L. Reed, both of

Chestertown, MD, two sisters: Clara Reed of Chestertown, MD and Linda Joiner of Rock Hall, MD, and three grandchildren: Wittney Reed, Lynn Reed, and Reagan Reed.

Services will be held at 1:00pm on Friday, January 23, 2009, at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home, 130 Speer Road Chestertown, MD where relatives and friends may call on Thursday, January 22, 2009 from 6-8pm and again on Friday, January 23, 2009 one hour prior to the service (12-1pm).
