



Cecil Browne

September 2, 1926 - June 17, 2009

Cecil Browne died peacefully in his sleep on Wednesday, June 17, 2009 at his home in Trappe. He was 82.

The only son of Rollin and Doonya Browne, he is survived by his wife of 57 years, Jessie; son Rollin Browne and his wife, Cindy; two daughters, Melissa Browne and Sarah Mueller and her husband, John; and six grandchildren, Rachel, Jessie, Nathan, Micah, Jacqueline, and Stephanie.

He was born in New York City and spent much of his youth in Talbot County at his family home outside Easton. During World War II, he served as a cadet midshipman in the Merchant Marine, including six months of convoy duty in the North Atlantic. A graduate of Princeton University and Columbia Law School, he practiced law in New York City, and after returning to Talbot County as a full time resident in 1971, he practiced in Easton until his retirement in 1996.

Mr. Browne was a hunting and fishing enthusiast. He enjoyed bird shooting, always awaiting the opening of each dove season. An avid sport fisherman for all of his adult life, he ran his own boat fishing offshore in Maryland, North Carolina, Florida, and the Bahamas. For 17 years he held an all tackle world record for Atlantic Big Eye Tuna. He also spent many happy hours fishing on the Chesapeake Bay and Choptank River with family and friends.

He was a member of the Mayflower Society, Chesapeake Bay Yacht Club, and Legal Limit Dove Club.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, June 20, 2009 at 11:00 am at St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Trappe, followed by a reception at the parish house.
