Cecilia Wyvill Ripple died on Wednesday, July 13, 2005. She was 85.

Born in Upper Marlboro, MD on March 11, 1920, she was the daughter of the late Samuel A. and Barbara E. Schultz Wyvill. Following graduation from Marlboro High School, she attended Trinity College in Washington, D.C. In 1940, she married Roland Cyril Ripple, who died in 1978.

“Cele”, as she was affectionately known, was organist and choir director for St. Michaels Chapel in St. Michaels for twenty-seven years. She was a former Grand-Regent of the Catholic Daughters of America in Upper Marlboro, a former President and member of St. Anne & Joachim Society, and a member of the Bible Study Group at Sts.
