C. Edna Taylor died December 7 at the Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 91.

Born in Easton on September 8, 1919, she was the daughter of James Edward and Clara Breeding Dean. She graduated from Easton High School. On October 6, 1940, she married LeRoy Raymond Taylor, who died on May 11, 1987. Mrs. Taylor worked as a crossing guard, most often in the vicinity of Aurora St., Magnolia St., and Mt. Pleasant Ave.
