



Charity Emma Kelley Clement

September 6, 1942 - February 20, 2025

Charity Emma Kelley Clement was born on September 6, 1942, in Bethlehem, Maryland to the late Andrew Kelley Sr. and Beatrice King Kelley. She was the fifth child from that union of eight and was raised with her siblings on the Kelley Family Farm.

After graduating from Lockerman High School in Denton, MD in 1960, she was the fourth child to attend Morgan State University, and was granted a Bachelor's Degree in 1964.

She soon came to live with her sister, Elloise, in Brooklyn, NY. There she commenced a courageous 37-year career with the NY Administration for Child Services. Often staying late, testifying in court, and sometimes accompanied by NYPD, she championed children of all backgrounds, seeing to it that no child would suffer under her watch.

In 1967, Charity married Nathaniel Donald Clement in the family's church in Bethlehem, MD. Out of this union came their only child, Nicole Desiree Clement. Charity retired in 1996 to welcome her first grandchild, Sojourner Glasgow. Twelve years later, she continued to devote her time to her grandson, Jaylen Ingram.

For decades, Charity lived her life with fierceness and fairness. She

emphasized to us that our voices must be trumpets for those who need us. She would often say “if it’s gold, it will shine”. And even in the dark days, if there was one light you would see, it was hers. A life well served; a job well done.

Charity Emma Kelley Clement, our beloved “Booster”, peacefully entered eternal rest on February 20, 2025. She leaves to cherish her daughter, Nicole D. Clement of Harrisburg, PA, her granddaughter, Sojourner Glasgow of Neptune, NJ, and her grandson, Jaylen Ingram of Harrisburg, PA. She also leaves behind her siblings, Hattie Mae Jackson, Tessie Madden, Elloise Kelley, Dr. Lillian Cannon, Percell Kelley, Mary Twyman, Blanche Olliviere and Hazel Prattis, as well as a host of nieces, nephews, friends and neighbors.
