Charles Augustus Reamy of Stevensville, MD, died on Saturday, May 22, 2004, at his home. He was 83.

Born in Chester, MD, on January 26, 1921, he was the son of the late Augustus K. and Mary A. Graham Reamy. He joined the Merchant Marines and traveled throughout the world in the late 1940's and early 1950's. He married Betty Lou Burns of Chester, MD, and together they ran the White House Restaurant in Stevensville, MD. Mr. Reamy also had a career working for the ferry system and as a waterman for some years. For the remainder of his life he worked as a farmer, for Carville Tolson and the Mattapex Plantation in Stevensville, MD. His wife, Betty Lou Burns Reamy, predeceased him in 1988.

Mr. Reamy is survived by one son, Garry Reamy of Grasonville, MD; one daughter, Debra Lynn Reamy of Stevensville, MD; one daughter-in-law, Bonnie S. Reamy of Grasonville, MD; two sisters, Elsie Porter of Stevensville, MD, and Elizabeth Haddaway of Grasonville, MD; and two granddaughters, Jennifer M. Reamy and Rebecca E. Reamy, both of Grasonville, MD.

In addition to his wife, Betty Lou, one brother, Presley G. Reamy, and three sisters, Martha Pearl Gardner, Edna A. Britt, and Irma Britt predeceased him.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, May 25, 2004, at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A. Chester, MD at 11 AM. Family and friends may call to the funeral home on Monday, May 24, 2004, between the hours of 6 and 8 pm. Burial will immediately follow at Stevensville Cemetery.
