Charles Roy Boyer, 57, of Centreville, MD, died on June 4 at the Chester River Hospital Center.

Born on February 28, 1957, he was son of Ed and Flora Hollifield, and grew up in the Riva neighborhood in Annapolis. Charles enlisted in the Navy in 1974, and served until his honorable discharge in 1976. After his enlistment, he returned to the Annapolis area, and worked as a carpenter in both residential and commercial construction. 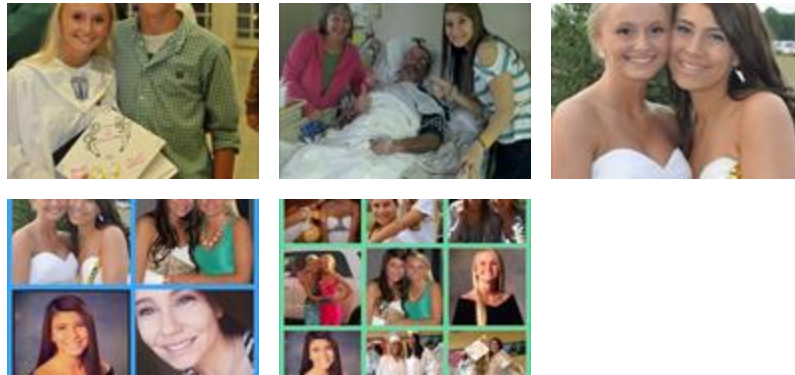

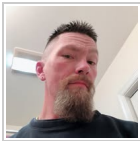

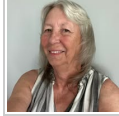
