July 11, 1938 - July 25, 2013

Charles E. "Chuck" Briddell died peacefully at home on July 25, 2013, in St. Michaels, MD, surrounded by his loving family. He was 75 years old.

Chuck was born July 11, 1938, in Baltimore, MD, the son of the late C. Orville Briddell and Ruth Ridgely Briddell. He graduated from Friends School and attended the University of Maryland. He worked for the C. E. Briddell Company, his family's upholstery and drapery fabric business until it was sold. He continued in the business for several years. After moving to St. Michaels, MD, in 1986, Chuck worked as a self-employed contractor until his retirement.

While attending Friends School, Chuck was on the 1954 lacrosse team. In 2004, the team was inducted into the Athletic Hall of Fame, and in 2012, he was inducted as an individual player. He was an active member of the MRYC for 25 years, serving on the Board of Governors and was a founding member of The Anglers. He enjoyed boating, golfing, hunting, and was an avid fisherman. One of his proudest accomplishments was being a member of AA for the past 12 years. The family was very supportive and shared in his success. He made many friends and was always there to offer his support. He traveled to the Whitsitt Center in Chestertown once a month to speak to those trying to recover.

Chuck is survived by his wife, Lynn, of 39 years; sons, Charles Briddell,

Michael Briddell (Susan), James Briddell (Allyson) and daughter Allison "Pickle" Briddell; six grandchildren, Megan, Christopher, Abigail, Mollie, Ridgely, and Ryleigh; two sisters, Anne Handley and Wink Cowee (Dan); several nieces and nephews; and best friend and buddy, his cocker spaniel, Chloe.
