



Charles "Charlie" Frederick Bohn Jr.

September 9, 1947 - February 7, 2025

It is with profound sadness that we announce the passing of Charles "Charlie" Frederick (aka Funny and Flexible) Bohn, Jr., on February 7, 2025, aged 77. He was born on September 9, 1947, in New York City, to Charles Frederick Bohn and Julia Quigley Bohn.

Charlie earned his AA from Valley Forge Military Academy, BBA from the University of Massachusetts, Amherst, followed by an MBA from Syracuse University. A proud veteran, Charlie served in the US Army from 1969-1972, including a tour in Vietnam, where he rose to the rank of 1st Lieutenant. An avid fisherman, on January 16, 1971, Charlie married the catch of his life, Jan (Baldini) Bohn, a union that lasted 54 years. Charlie was a proud father of three wonderful children: Caroline Bohn of Easton, Robert Bohn, of Atlanta, GA, and Betsy Bohn Painter, of Hoboken, NJ. He found immense joy in being "Umpa" to his beloved grandchildren: Ann-Harmon Bohn, Charles Bohn, and Emma Painter.

Professionally, Charlie had a distinguished career at Citibank, where he dedicated 35 years of his life, culminating in his role as Managing Director and Group Executive of the Global Power, Energy, Chemicals, and Mining Group. He was responsible for delivering Citibank's services to approximately 500 global clients, a testament to his expertise and dedication to his field. Beyond his professional achievements, Charlie was deeply committed to his

community. He served on the Board of Habitat Choptank for eight years, including roles as Treasurer for four years and President for two. He was awarded the Habitat for Humanity Choptank Founders award, aka, the Golden Shovel Award, for outstanding service to Habitat. Charlie also served as Treasurer to the Episcopal Diocese of Easton and Senior Warden to Trinity Cathedral and All Faith Chapel. He was a volunteer mediator at the Mid-Shore Community Mediation Center for over 10 years, where he was honored as Mediator of the Year in 2017.

Charlie is survived by his beloved wife, Jan; his children, Caroline, Robert (Jessica), and Betsy (Justin); his grandchildren, Ann-Harmon, Charles, and Emma; his sister, Catherine Howard Fischer; and his fifth beloved standard poodle Rusty. He touched many lives and will be greatly missed.

Services will be held at Christ Church, 111 S. Harrison St., Easton, MD on Saturday, February 15, 2025, at 10:30 AM.
