



## Charles "Chuck" Beaumont Davison III

November 10, 1956 - August 6, 2014

Charles "Chuck" Beaumont Davison, III, died on August 6, 2014, at his home in Chester, MD. He was 57.

Born in Washington, DC, on November 10, 1956, the son of the late Charles Beaumont and Kathleen (Bowman) Davison, he grew up in Chevy Chase, MD. Chuck graduated from Bethesda Chevy Chase High School Class of 1974. 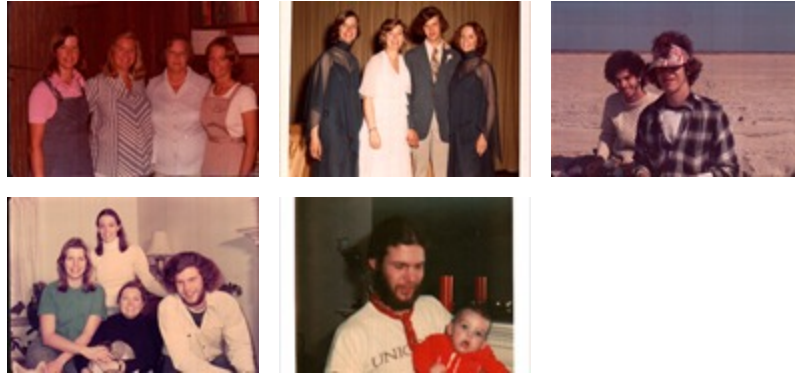
