Charles “Buddy” Edward Cohey of Chestertown, MD, died Saturday, July 5, 2003 at the Kent and Queen Anne’s Hospital in Chestertown, MD. He was 89.

Born September 19, 1913 in Ridgely, MD, he was the son of the late Charles Henry and Ella Beatrice Irlend Cohey. Mr. Cohey served his country in the United States Navy and served for two years before being discharged due to injury. He returned from service and became part owner of Bennett and Cohey Salvage Yard where he worked for 58 years.

Mr. Cohey was a dedicated member of the American Legion Post #36 and was also a member of the Farm Bureau. Mr. Cohey loved gardening and took a lot of pride in his garden making sure that he was always first with his yield of produce before anyone else. Mr. Cohey also enjoyed bowling in his earlier years.

He was preceded in death by three sisters and one brother.

“Buddy” Cohey is survived by his wife of 64 years, Pauline D. Cohey of Chestertown, MD; two sisters, Virginia Cohey Oaks of Chestertown, MD and Betty Wallraven of Millington, MD; three brothers, Leonard M. Cohey, Allen H. Cohey and Mervin R.
