



Charles Johnson Damron

July 10, 1932 - December 11, 2011

Charles Johnson Damron of Grasonville died at his home surrounded by his loving family on Sunday, December 11, 2011. He was 79.

Born in Shelby Gap, Kentucky on July 10, 1932, he was the son of Crittendon Parcus Damron and Ella Eugenia Johnson. Mr. Damron served in the United States Navy during the Korean War on board the USS Toledo CA 133, where he was a Damage Controlman, DC 1st Class. After his service, Mr. Damron graduated from the University of Kentucky in 1959 with a degree in Civil Engineering. He worked as Civil Engineer, retiring from the State of Maryland as the Deputy Director of Construction.
