



## Charles Wesley Dulin

October 22, 1923 - February 23, 2016

Charles Wesley Dulin of Chestertown, MD, passed away on February 23, 2016, at University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Chestertown. He was 92.

Born on October 22, 1923, in Easton, MD, he was the son of the late Carroll and Hazel Waldron Dulin. He graduated early from Chestertown High School and attended Washington College, where he earned a Bachelor's of Science degree. Mr. Dulin served in the U.S. Air Force, as a mechanic, and was honorably discharged in 1945. He later received a Master's Degree in Organic Chemistry, from University of Maryland in 1953 and went to work for Catalyst Research in Baltimore. Mr. Dulin returned to the Eastern Shore and worked with LaMotte Chemical Company for 35 years, until his retirement.

Mr. Dulin loved Chestertown and enjoyed all the friendships he had made. He looked forward to meeting with his dear friends on a weekly basis. He was a member of the Chestertown Lion's Club. Mr. Dulin had a lifelong passion for fishing, boating, crossword puzzles, and playing Gin Rummy.

He leaves behind his two devoted sons, John Dulin, and his wife, Sharon of Raynham, MA, and Roger Noldon, and his wife, Lisa of Stewartstown, PA, and Pearl Ley Dulin, wife of his late son, Charles of Montclair, NJ.
