Charles Gallozzi of Easton, MD died on Sunday, September 9, 2001 at William Hill Manor, Easton. He was 89.

Born, November 12, 1911, in Philadelphia, PA he was the son of the late Carlos and Lena Gallozzi. He was raised in New York City where he attended school. Following his graduation from high school, he received a scholarship to Columbia University where he received a BA Degree. He then went to Rutgers University, where he received a Masters Degree in Library Science. During WWII he served with the Merchant Marines. He then worked for the Free Library of Philadelphia Division For The Blind, where he remained until 1958. He then took a position with the Library of Congress, where he was Assistant Chief of the Division For The Blind and Physically Handicapped. He retired from this position in 1975. During his working career he received a number of awards for outstanding service. Following his retirement he moved to Tilghman Island and then in 1999 moved to Easton.

A life member of the West River Sailing Club of Galesville, MD, he was also a former member of the Easton Lions Club and his hobbies included medieval literature and art.

Mr. Gallozzi is survived by his wife the former Bernice Barlow; one son, Charles A. Gallozzi of Toronto, Canada; a brother, John Gallozzi of California;

two grandchildren and four great grandchildren.
