Charles David Haslup, Sr., also lovingly known as “Dave” or “Nut,” 55, of Easton, MD, passed away peacefully on October 9, 2012. He fought a long and courageous battle with ALS. His wife, son, and faithful companion, Drake, were by his side.

Dave was born in Baltimore, MD, on April 11, 1957. He graduated from Easton High School and continued on to receive an Associates Degree from Chesapeake College, and a Bachelor's Degree from Salisbury University. Following college, he worked in various jobs in the building industry before opening his own company, Tred Avon Building Supply. Eventually, he merged this business and created Charter Cabinetry where he worked until the fall of 2006.

Dave was an avid athlete who enjoyed playing and watching all kinds of sports, including football, baseball and softball, racquetball, golf, and basketball. He was also actively involved in the BPOE 1622 Elks Club and the Easton Rotary Club. He coached youth teams in soccer, basketball, and baseball for many years in the community. He also volunteered with the Waterfowl Festival for several years.
