Charles "Buddy" Howard Hawkins of Chestertown, MD, passed away Tuesday, July 1, 2014, in Chestertown, MD. He was 60.

Mr. Hawkins was born July 4, 1953, in Chestertown, MD, the son of Charles T. Hawkins and the late Doris Mae "Horney" Hawkins. Buddy was a 1970 graduate of Chestertown High School.
