



## Charles Wendell Lednum

April 16, 1923 - June 29, 2015

Charles Wendell Lednum, 92, died on Monday, June 29, 2015, at Maryland Shore Medical Center, in Easton, MD.

He was born April 16, 1923, at Willow Hill Farm, where he was living at the time of his passing. Wendell was the son of the late Hazel Hopkins Lednum and the late Harry Richard Lednum. He was one of the two oldest graduates of Cordova High School. Wendell was a farmer from the time he could pick up a pitchfork. He was proud of raising and milking 68 Gurnsey cows daily by hand, then machine. He used to walk behind horses, or mules, tilling the soil the old-fashioned way. He lived to see the transition to automated harvesting and sowing.

After leaving active farming, Wendell worked for 18 years at McKenny Willis (now ConAgra) as a dispatcher, as a private painting contractor, and as a substitute bailiff for the Talbot County Court House, under Judge Horne. In between time, Wendell taught ballroom dancing. Predeceasing him was his sister, Mary L. Kay, Wilmington, DE, beloved brother-in-law, John S. Nash, and his former wife, Rahe K. Lednum.

Surviving him and missing his ready smile, keen sense of humor, and fancy whistling are his wife of twenty-two years, Florence Nash Lednum, two stepdaughters, Dawn Rieken Weisbord and her husband Robert of Narberth, PA and Holly Rieken Ireland of Centreville, MD; three stepgrandchildren,

Sarah Ireland, Sylvie Weisbord, and John S.N. Weisbord, all of whom he loved and cherished.

A Celebration of his Life will be held at Trinity Episcopal Cathedral, Goldsborough Street, Easton, MD. on Friday, July 3, 2015, at 1:00 p.m. Interment will be private.
