



## Charles Phillip Marshall Sr.

September 12, 1927 - May 26, 2018

Charles Phillip Marshall, Sr., 90, died on May 26, 2018, at the Dixon House in Easton, MD.

Born September 12, 1927, in Princess Anne, MD, he was the son of the late Raymond Marshall, Sr. and Florence Tarbutton Marshall. He grew up in St. Michaels and graduated from St. Michaels High School, excelling in basketball, baseball and ping-pong.

Charles served honorably in the U. S. Air Force from October 1945 to October 1948 working as a meteorologist in the Arctic.

He married the former Jean Golt on April 13, 1956, and they made their home in Easton.

Charles was employed with the U.S. Post Office starting in 1960 and retiring in 1987. He also worked in insurance and auto parts sales. After retiring, he enjoyed refinishing furniture and spending time at Todd's Market at the picnic table with friends and neighbors.

He was a former member of the St. Michaels Volunteer Fire Company, VFW, Elks, American Legion and the Miles River Yacht Club.

Charles is survived by his sons, Charles Phillip Marshall, Jr. (Joy) of Easton, and Michael Rodney Marshall (Julia) of Washington, DC; grandchildren, Doug Rathell (Brooke), Kelley Mixon (Andy) and Caroline Marshall; and five great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife, Jean Marshall, and siblings, Esther Marshall Jones, W. Raymond Marshall, Jr., Florence M. George, Betty Seymour, M. Frances Covey and Elsie M. Jones.
