



## Charles Edward Moon

May 2, 1928 - September 28, 2018

Charles Edward Moon of Easton, MD, passed away peacefully at his home on September 28, 2018. He was 90.

Born in Toledo, OH, on May 2, 1928, he was the son of the late Orland and Beulah Moon. Mr. Moon honorably served his country both during World War II in the US Navy, and during the Korean War in the US Air Force. He worked for Giant Food for 22 years, retiring as the Vice President of Construction Shops. On November 7, 1953, he married the former Patricia Clower. The Moons made their home first in College Park and then in Crofton before moving to Easton in 2003.

Mr. Moon was an avid golfer and Redskins fan. He always put his family first and loved to be with them whether he was playing golf, taking beach vacations, or simply spending time with his grandchildren. He was a member of St. Marks United Methodist Church, and was a previous member of the Easton Club, the Crofton Country Club, the Prince George's Country Club, Davidsonville United Methodist Church, and Glenn Dale United Methodist Church.

He is survived by his loving wife of almost 65 years, Patricia Moon; his children, Jeffrey Moon (Jacqueline) of Westminster, MD, Martin Moon (Paula) of Crofton, MD, and Lisa Foley (Scott) of Bel Air, MD; a brother in-law, Hugh

Clower of Chesapeake Beach, MD; a sister in-law, Lois Moon of Circleville, OH; eight grandchildren, Catherine (Mark), Christine (Daniel), Stephanie (Austin), Melanie, Michael (Angela), Kelsey, Matthew and Luke; and two great-grandchildren on the way. He was preceded in death by his brothers, Delmar Moon and Larry Moon.
