Charles E. Otis, lovingly known as "Buck," passed away peacefully on September 19th, 2024, at the age of 100. Born on June 24, 1924, Buck lived a long and fulfilling life marked by his love for family, country, and faith.

On April 24, 1948, Buck married Marian Louise, the love of his life, and together they raised a beautiful family of eight children—four boys and four girls. He was predeceased by his wife Marian and a son, Charles E. Otis, III.
