



Charles Ellis Parks

January 20, 1936 - January 31, 2023

Charles Ellis Parks “Ellis” of Easton, MD, passed away peacefully on January 31, 2023. He was born in Easton on January 20, 1936, to Charles O. and Emma Louise Parks (Parrott).

Ellis graduated from Easton High School in 1954. In 1955, he began to work for C&P Telephone company. He worked as a lineman, installation and repair technician and finished his career of 37 years in 1992 in the Central Office. Ellis was a life member of the Easton Elks Lodge #1622 and Exalted Ruler in 1979.

On January 19, 1963, Ellis was joined in marriage to Patricia A. Favinger at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church by the Right Reverend, Monsignor, Joseph H. Irwin. Ellis and Pat just celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary.

In addition to his wife, Ellis is survived by a daughter Carole Ann Clem and her husband Warren; daughter-in-law, Mandy Parks; grandchildren, Adam J. Parks (Katie), Seth Parks, Graydon Clem (Sierra), Allison Clem; and one great-grandson, Hudson Ellis Parks. He is also survived by a sister, Nancy Webster, and two brothers, Stephen Parks and Keith Parks. In addition to his parents, Ellis was preceded in death by a sister, Ellen Parks Lane, and a son, C. Jeffrey Parks.

There will be a viewing on Friday February 10, 2023, from 5 p.m. until 7 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home in Easton. 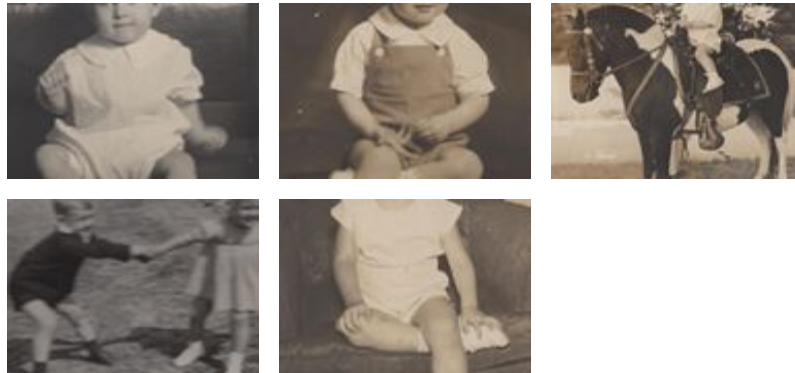
