Charles F. Pesnell, 56, of Centreville, MD died unexpectedly on December 11 2023.

Charley was born in Bakersfield, CA on October 2, 1967. He was lovingly adopted by Sam and Anna Pesnell and grew up in Big Springs, TX.

In 1990, Charley entered the US Army in El Paso, TX. He was soon stationed in Fort Meade, where he met the love of his life, Maria. They married in 1993 and recently celebrated their 30th wedding anniversary. He retired to the rank of Sergeant 1st Class in 2011 in Hawaii. After retirement, he was employed to Afghanistan to support Operation Enduring Freedom. He then returned back home to Maria and was employed by the Navy as a Federal Employee. Charley contributed his time and talents helping the church. He achieved the honors of Fourth Degree of the Knights of Columbus.
