Charles James Radvan “Chuck”, 86, of Easton, MD, passed away peacefully on Thursday, April 24, 2025, at South River Healthcare in Edgewater, MD.

Born on October 13, 1938, in Tarentum, PA, Chuck was the son of the late Steven and Anita Radvan. Following his high school years, Chuck proudly served his country in the National Guard. His commitment to service was followed by a pursuit of knowledge, culminating in a bachelor’s degree in business from Penn State University. The day after graduation marked the beginning of an exciting chapter as he headed west to California, where he embarked on a career in financial services and fatefully met his beloved wife, Beverly.

Chuck and Beverly were married in 1966 in Redondo Beach, CA, and together they were blessed with two daughters, Kimberly and Stephanie. Soon after, Chuck transitioned his career to Human Resources at Mobil Oil. His hard work and dedication led to promotions and transfers, first in 1976 to Schaumburg, IL, and later in 1984 to Yardley, PA. After a successful career, Chuck retired from Mobil Oil in 1994, embracing a new passion in horticulture, where he found joy in designing beautiful Koi ponds for residential properties.

In 2012, Chuck and Beverly relocated to Easton, MD, along with Beverly’s mother, Lorraine Warner, to be closer to their daughter Kimberly and son-in-

law, Rob. Chuck embraced the beauty of the Eastern Shore in his final years, finding community at Grace Lutheran Church and enjoying leisurely walks with their two cherished dogs, Jazzy and Lilly.

Chuck was preceded in death by his parents, his daughter Stephanie, and his brother Stephen. He is survived by his beloved wife, Beverly Radvan, and his loving daughter, Kim Radvan-Jerome.
