



## Charles Still

August 18, 1922 - June 23, 2012

Charles William Still of Chesterown, MD, died Friday, June 22, 2012, at the University of Maryland in Baltimore, MD. He was 90.

Charles William Still was born August 18, 1921, in Whitehall, MD the son of William Fred Still and Mary "Jones" Still. Mr. Still joined the Air Force September 5, 1942, and served through 1947.

After an honorable discharge he went to work for Terl's Hardware in Baltimore, MD. He went to work for Northern Police Dept. in 1955 , then worked for Mangels and Harold King Syrup in the early 1960's, and then worked for the Greater Baltimore Medical Center in 1980, retiring six years later. He married his late wife, Frances "Gummel" Still. After her death he re-married to Betty Redman in 1995. Mr. Still was a member of the Parkville American Legion. He enjoyed working and hunting here on the Eastern Shore with his close friend Roger Mangels.

He is preceded in death by two brothers, Robert and Edward Still, and one sister, Betty Still.

He is survived by his daughter, Linda Mancuso and her husband Louis of Betterton, MD; four grandchildren, Mandy, Carrie, Louis and John; and eight great-grandchildren.

A visitation will be held Thursday, June 28, 2012, from 6-8 p.m. at Trinity Lutheran Church. Services will be held Friday, June 29, 2012, at 10 a.m. also at the church. Burial will be held in Hampstead Cemetery in Hampstead, MD.
