December 15, 1948 - July 26, 2025

Charles Raymond Taylor, of Church Hill, passed away on July 26, 2025, surrounded by his loving family at Compass Regional Hospice Center in Centreville, Maryland.

Charles was born on December 15, 1948, to the late Raymond and Kathleen Taylor. He was a proud member of the Queen Anne's High School Class of 1968. After graduating, Charles began his career driving an oil truck for seven years, later transitioning to driving a sprayer for several more.

In 1968, Charles married the love of his life, Clara. A lifelong resident of Church Hill. He previously served with the Jaycees in Centreville and was president of the Chester River Advocates for the Blind.

Charles enjoyed baseball and NASCAR, enjoyed doing yard work, and treasured the time spent with friends, especially over a meal of crabs. Above all, he cherished every moment with his grandchildren.

Along with his parents he is preceded in death by his loving wife Clara and his brother Marvin Taylor.

He is survived by his son, Stephen Taylor (Joy) of Millington, MD; two beloved grandchildren, Noah Jonathan Taylor and Delaney Grace Taylor, both of Millington, MD; and three sisters, Jeanne Scharch of Puyallup, WA, Grace West of Laurel, DE, and Shirley Burnham of Laurel, DE.

Charles's legacy also lives on through his godchildren: Kellie Bender and Chelsea Bender, both of Kennedyville, and Michael Thompson of Chestertown.

A visitation will be held at Fellows Family Funeral Home in Millington, MD, on Friday, August 1st, from 9:00 to 11:00 AM, followed by a funeral service at 11:00 AM. Interment will take place immediately after the service at Church Hill Cemetery in Church Hill, MD.

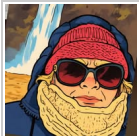
