May 28, 1931 - August 18, 2023

Charles S. Waesche, Jr., of Rock Hall, MD, died on August 18, 2023, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Chestertown. He was 92.

Charlie was born in Baltimore on May 28, 1931. He was raised in Baltimore and graduated from Forest Park High School Class of 1949 and Washington College in Chestertown, MD, Class of 1953, where he also played lacrosse.

He practiced law for several years before becoming an educator, teaching history at Forest Park High School where he also coached football, basketball, and lacrosse. He was beloved by his students and athletes. He kept in touch with his students, holding annual summer get togethers. He and his wife, Gail Robertson Waesche, moved to Rock Hall in 1993. Charlie loved golf and was a member of Chester River Yacht and Country Club.

He was awarded a mayoral citation for his contribution as an educator and coach.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by his daughters, Carol Anne Waesche of Lexington Park, MD, and Diane Cowell of Westminster, MD.

A visitation will be held on Thursday, August 24, 2023, from 4 - 6 p.m. where a service will be held at 6 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral
