Charles E. Wiscott of Stevensville, MD, died Friday, October 15, 2004, at Mallard Bay Nursing Center, Cambridge, MD. He was 78.

Born on September 21, 1926, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Milton L. and Mary Hansley Wiscott. In September 1943, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy during WW II and served in the Pacific and was a Purple Heart recipient. While serving on the U.S.S. Holder, a torpedo sunk the ship, which resulted in him being one of the few who survived. In May 1946, he was discharged from the service due to an illness. On September 19, 1962, he married the former Mary G. Asbury of WV, and they began their home in Odenton, MD. He and his family later moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland, residing on Kent Island in 1969.

Mr. Wiscott enjoyed boating, fishing, crabbing and gardening.

In addition to his wife, Mary G. Wiscott, he is survived by two children, Amy Wenck and her husband, David, of Centreville, MD, and John Wiscott of Stevensville, MD; two sisters, Ruth Caldwell of Ellicott City, MD, and Doris Pittman of Miami, FL; and four grandchildren, Michael Riddell, Ryan Riddell, Nichole Wenck and Krystal Heinlein. One brother, Milton Wiscott, predeceased him.
