



Charles Allen Satterfield

Charles A. "Chuck" Satterfield of Sudlersville, Maryland, died Sunday, September 5, 2004, of a heart attack at Memorial Hospital at Easton, Maryland. He was 66 years old.

Born outside of Sudlersville on July 2, 1938, he was the eldest son of Lula T. and the late George Aldrich "Dickie" Satterfield. He was a graduate of Sudlersville High School, Class of 1956 and was a volunteer fireman with the Sudlersville Fire Company in the 1950s.

Mr. Satterfield served 9 years in the U.S. Navy and was a First Class Machinist Mate on vessels including the U.S.S. Daniel A. Joy and the U.S.S. Radford. Before retiring, he worked for 30 years at the Chrysler Assembly plant in Newark, Delaware and was a member of the United Auto Workers Union, Local 1183. He also held part time employment repairing boats at Chester River Boat Sales near Millington for many years.

He was a dedicated Christian and a faithful member of the First United Pentecostal Church of Dover, Delaware, for over 30 years.

He recently served a 3-year term as a Sudlersville Town Commissioner. His hobbies included hunting, gun collecting, repairing Chrysler vehicles, enjoying history and historic places, and NASCAR racing. He delighted in spending time with his grandchildren.

Mr. Satterfield is survived by his wife of 45 years, Nancy Elizabeth Dedrick Satterfield; his mother, Lula Thompson Satterfield and his brothers, William and Ronald Satterfield, all of Sudlersville. Also surviving him are many aunts, uncles and cousins and his children and grandchildren, including his son, David Satterfield and his children Sarah "Niki", Alice, Shelley, Hannah, Maggie, Valerie, Harley and Lula of Eureka, California; his daughter, Suzanne Johnson and her sons, Kevin, Daniel and Nathaniel Smith of Dover; his son, George Satterfield and his wife, Deborah and their children, Clay, Garrett, Alexis and Lacey of Magnolia, Delaware; his daughter, Valerie and her husband, Robert Csizmadia of Dover and their children, Belinda and Kendell of Butler, Pennsylvania; and his son, James and his wife, Beth and their children, Matthew, Ethan and Rebecca of Dover.

The viewing will be held from 11:00 a.m. to noon on Thursday, September 9, 2004, at the First United Pentecostal Church in Kent Christian Center , Dover, DE Routes 1 & 13. The funeral service will follow at quarter past in the same location. Mr. Satterfield will be buried at Busic Cemetery near Templeville, Maryland.
