



## Charles Anthony George Sr.

Mr. Charles A. George "Buddy", Sr. died Tuesday, September 12, 2006 at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 73.

Charles A. George, Sr. was born on September 9, 1933 in Baltimore, MD to the late Frederick J. George and Theresa G. Baumgartner George. He began working on a paper route at a young age, until working with his father painting automobiles for Kelly Pontiac. On November 6, 1954 he married Trudy Ann Schafer and resided in Baltimore. In 1960, Mr. George began working as a police officer for the Baltimore City Police Department. After retiring in 1980, he went back into active duty for the National Guard, retiring with 28 years of service. In 1984, he and his wife moved to Kent Island.

In 1996, he began working for the Maryland State Police in Howard County, working in Criminal Intelligence, and in 2001 took a position with the U.S. Marshall's in Baltimore as a deputy for court security.

Mr. George is a member of the St. Christopher's Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus, Sergeant Major Association, the Police Benevolent Association and American Legion Post #278. He enjoys cutting grass, wood carving and oil painting.

In addition to his wife, Trudy, he is survived by two sons, Keith George, Sr. and his wife Karen, and Brian George, Sr. and his wife Robin; one sister,

Theresa Winterstein; three brothers, Nicholas George, Sr., Francis George and Frederick George; and five grandchildren, Keith Jr., Kyle, Brian Jr., Caitlyn and Andrew; one son, Charles George, Jr., predeceased him on March 20, 1992.
